

Simple Chunky Wristers

(original pattern written by Tommi Johnstone and available at TinctureCraft.com)

Finished Size: Women's Medium, approximately 7" in length and 8" around at wrist end.

Skill: Beginner

Please note: Wrist opening is not stretchy. If your hand will not fit through an 8" opening, you can adjust opening size by adding additional stitches in the initial ring. Overall size of wrister can be made smaller or larger by decreasing or increasing number of stitches in each round or by using a smaller or larger size hook.

MATERIALS

2 strands bulky weight yarn (category 5) held together

Crochet hook, size M

GAUGE:

6 hdc + 5 rows = 4 in.

FINGERLESS GLOVES (make 2)

Ch 13. Being careful not to twist the chain, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch1, 13 hdc in in ring, join with sl st in top of first hdc. (13 hdc)

Round 2 & 3: Ch 1, hdc in same hdc as sl st, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st in top of first hdc. (13 hdc)

Round 4: Ch 1, 2 hdc in same hdc as sl st, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st in top of first hdc. (14 hdc)

Round 5: Ch 1, 3 hdc in same hdc as sl st, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st in top of first hdc. (16 hdc)

Round 6: Ch 1, hdc in same hdc as sl st, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st in top of first hdc. (16 hdc)

Round 7: Ch 4, sk 3 hdc, hdc in next hdc and each following hdc around, join with sl st in second sc. (12 hdc)

Round 8: Ch 1, 2 hdc in ch 2 sp, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st in top of first hdc. (14 hdc)

Round 9: Ch 1, hdc in same hdc as sl st, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st in top of first hdc. Fasten off. (14 hdc)

THUMB

Join yarn to any hdc along opening for thumb. Ch1, sc in same hdc as joining, work 9 sc evenly around thumb opening, join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off. (10 sc)

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Add buttons, pom-poms, crochet flowers, lace trim, or other embellishments as desired.
